
We came through wishing all a very Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year.



#### Buy \$mart, Eat Well SAUSAGE, POTATO & KALE SOUP

#### **Ingredients**

- 2 bunches of kale
- 12 whole red potatoes, sliced thin (or 6-9 regular potatoes) (5lb russet potatoes on sale \$1.99 each!)
- 1 whole onion, chopped (yellow onions on sale \$0.39lb!)
- 1 1/2lbs Italian sausage
- (Johnsonville Italian Sausage 19oz on sale \$4.49!) • 1/2 tsp. red pepper flakes (more to taste)
- 2 cups low sodium chicken broth
- 2 cups whole milk
- 4 cups half-and-half
- · splash of heavy cream
- · fresh or dried oregano
- · black pepper to taste

#### Directions

- Tear the kale into pieces and rinse under cold water. Drain in a colander and set it aside.
- In a medium pot boil sliced potatoes until tender. Drain and set aside.
- In a large pot, crumble and brown the Italian sausage. Drain as much as the fat as you can. Stir in the red pepper flakes, oregano, chicken broth, milk, and half-and-half. Simmer for 30 minutes.
- Give it a taste and adjust seasonings as needed. Add the potatoes, a splash of heavy cream for richness, then stir in the kale. Simmer an additional 10-15 minutes, then serve.

Make it a Meal! To be on par with Olive Garden you could serve this with a fresh tossed salad (roma tomatoes on sale \$0.69lb!) and garlic bread sticks (New York garlic bread sticks on sale \$2.19!) Recipe found at www.pioneerwomancooks.com.





