The online applications must be submitted by midnight Monday, **February 08, 2016!** Other required documentation must be postmarked by Thursday, **February 18, 2016.** Final approval and notification of each scholarship recipient will be made by the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo Office of Educational Programs.

If needed students should see their school counselor, County Extension office, or Ag Science teachers for additional information.

The Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo will provide an \$18,000, four-year scholarship to an eligible, outstanding student from OUR County. So parents get your senior to working on completion of this application. They just might be the lucky recipient of the \$18,000 four-year scholarship for our county.

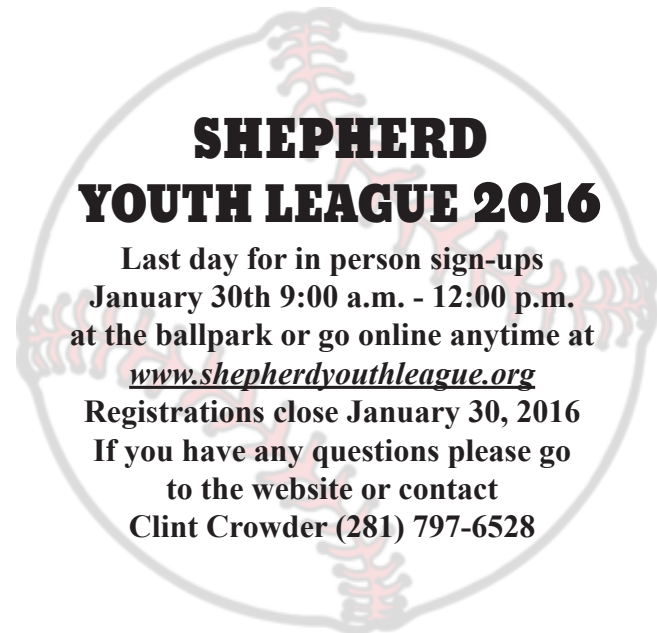

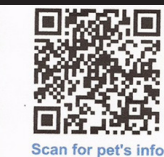

Famous Butter Chicken

Ingredients

- 4 boneless, skinless chicken breast halves (*on sale \$1.49lb!*)
- 2 eggs, beaten
- 1 cup crushed buttery round cracker crumbs (like Ritz)
- ½ cup of butter, cut into pieces
- ½ tsp. garlic salt
- Ground black pepper to taste

Directions

- Preheat oven to 375 degrees F (190 degrees C).
- Place eggs and cracker crumbs in two separate shallow bowls. Mix cracker crumbs with garlic salt and pepper. Dip chicken in the eggs, then dredge in the crumb mixture to coat.
- Arrange coated chicken in a 9x13 inch baking dish. Place pieces of butter around the chicken.
- Bake in the preheated oven for 40 minutes, or until chicken is no longer pink and juices run clear.
- Tip! Aluminum foil can be used to keep food moist, cook it evenly, and make cleanup easier.
