

SHS Second Annual Science Fair





Cherry Cheesecake Dip

Ingredients :

- 1 8oz. package of cream cheese, softened (**Kraft Philadelphia cream cheese 8oz. On Sale 2/\$3.00!**)
- 1 7oz. jar marshmallow cream
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 8oz. tub Cool Whip, thawed (**On Sale 5/\$5.00!**)
- 1 21oz. can cherry pie filling (**Comstock Pie Filling On Sale 2/\$5.00!**)

Ingredients :

- Turkey (**Jennie-O turkey On Sale \$0.39/lb!**)
- Roaster pan with lid
- Oleo (*shortening or butter*)

(Land o Lakes butter sticks On Sale 2/\$7.00!)



Directions :

- Preheat oven to 450 degrees.
- Rub turkey with salt and oleo (*shortening or butter*).

Place in roaster.

- Add 3 cups of water. Cover with roaster lid and place in pre-heated oven.
- Bake for 1 hour to 1 hour and 15 minutes depending on the size of your turkey.

(**This step is very important since baking at such a high temperature is what kills all the bacteria from the turkey.**)

- Turn off the oven but **DO NOT OPEN THE OVEN DOOR!**

Leave turkey in the oven all night and open at noon the next day.
