The local commission is responsible for the identification and preservation of locally significant historical landmarks and treasurers, as outlined in the Texas Local Government Code, chapter 318



It was a most interesting meeting and the new directors of Coldspring Library were also attending. The idea behind the gathering was to 'strengthen our communities by strengthening our libraries.' Special guests from the Tocker Foundation, which helps small rural libraries were there as well as the Board President of CETA, This stands for Central East Texas Alliance. Coldspring Chamber of Commerce is one of the founding members of this almost three year old organization, which seeks to help small communities like ours with grants and information. The meeting was in Onalaska and was organized by the Library Director there, Sherry Brecheen. We had a really good lunch too! Thank you Sherry for making this idea grow into reality.

Our libraries are one of the few, in fact often the only, facility in a small community which is available to all age groups. People use them to fax documents, use the computers, find forms and get information as well as take out books and movies. By the way, the next date for the Food Truck is November 21, which is a Monday. This is not the usual day but this month it will be there to help with Thanksgiving Dinner! The food distributed is free to anyone but you must walk through the line and collect a ticket, which you then present to the food servers. This food is brought by the Houston Food Bank, which has the rule that food be given to those who show up and get a ticket. 
