

Hwy 59 Shut Down for Several Hourse Due to Wreck

On Monday, December 21 at approximately 7:00 pm the San Jacinto County Sheriffs Office received a report of a one vehicle roll over accident on Hwy 59 South in Shepherd.

State Trooper Barnes was dispatched to investigate. Upon arrival, it was discovered the vehicle was a Loomis armored car. The driver tried to miss debris on the highway and in doing so, left the roadway to the right into the grassy area between Shepherd and the old truck stop. The driver tried to bring the vehicle back onto the roadway but overcompensated, resulting in the vehicle slamming into the concrete barrier. The vehicle was badly damaged and disabled by this time.

San Jacinto County Sheriffs Office deputies and Shepherd VFD were on scene assisting with traffic control.

Although traffic was stopped North bound on 59 for only a short period of time, those waiting in the South bound lanes were not so lucky and had almost 2+ hours of wait time. Hence the lack of pictures. The vehicle was recovered by East Texas Towing.



Unfortunately the weather prevented us from having the Lighted Parade and the entertainment at that time. This was a great pity because the floats which had been decorated were really something to see, but the rain and strong winds made it too difficult to carry on. A lot of hard work went into the planning and creation for this day, which started out well. There were lots of vendors with exceptional goods for sale. The musicians performed and kept everyone feeling happy and the Chamber offered hot coffee, cocoa and cookies from the Hospitality Room. We thank attorney Kerry Hagan for being so generous in letting us use his office for this purpose. Thank you every one who helped, especially the Chair for Christmas On The Square, Gayle Erwin, who is also the editor for the San Jacinto News Times.

Shepherd is now looking forward to regular visits each month from food trucks from S.N.A.P. This organization is out of Food Bank of Houston and the full name is Supplemental Nutritional Assistance Program. The initial enquiry about bringing the truck to Shepherd came from Michael Coker when he was Mayor of Shepherd. He followed up with them and with Commissioner Donny Marrs continues to help organize this very worthwhile venture for those people in need of such assistance. The Truck will be in Shepherd on the following dates below, distributing perishable foods to anyone who comes to Shepherd Community Center from 9:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. So many people showed up last time, (over 350!) that the food ran out before then! There are many volunteers helping in this event, and as is usually the case, these helpful people are also either members of such groups as Shepherd Chamber of Commerce, Shepherd Public Library and of course our great City workers. Patricia Marrs, Janice Chamblee and Helenmarie Johnson are some of these very helpful people from our community.

Michael Coker told me that because we are having such a great turnout for the SNAP Food Truck, they are now willing to allow the City to become partners with them. This means we can ask for particular items such as canned goods, meat items and cookies as well as staples such as rice and beans. To become a partner, those volunteers who help organize the events must take classes so they understand the process and see what can and can't be done, but once we do become partners with SNAP, we can look forward to a greater variety as well as two trucks coming to give away food. It may take until May for this to happen. Anyone can collect the food, you do not have to show ID or live in the City of Shepherd. The next food truck will be on December 28 and will have fruit and vegetables. Thereafter the truck will come to Shepherd on January 29, 2016; February 26; March 25; April 22; May 27. I will remind readers of these dates as we approach them.

Please remember to fill out the ballots for Best of San Jacinto County! You can go online to the Chamber web site and look in restaurants and Coldspring Chamber Office if you can't do that. You have till December 30 to turn them in. The Banquet will be on February 20 in Jones Auditorium, when the winners will be announced.
