



CHICKEN FRIED STEAK WELLSANDWICHES

Ingredients:

• 1-1 1/2 pounds cube steak or gravy steak cut into 4 bun size pieces (family pack tenderized beef gravy steaks on sale \$4.99lb!)

- 1 egg
- 1/2 cup milk
- 2/3 cup all purpose flour • 1 teaspoon season salt
- 1/2 teaspoon black pepper
- 2 cups vegetable oil (Wesson vegetable oil 48 oz. on sale \$2.99!)
- 4 buns (Mrs. Baird's large hamburger buns 8ct on sale 2/\$5.00!)
- 1/3 cup siracha comeback sauce, spicy mayo, or regular mayo
- Directions:
- Add oil to a large cast iron skillet and place over medium-high heat until
- oil reaches 350°F. • Add egg and milk to a bowl and beat together until mixed well. Add flour,
- season salt and pepper to another bowl and mix until well combined. • Dredge each steak in flour on both sides, dip into milk and then back into
- flour, coating both sides. Repeat with remaining steaks.
- Carefully add floured steaks into hot oil. Cook for 5-7 minutes on each
- side or until well browned. • Remove to a paper towel lined plate to drain.
- Spread Sriracha Comeback Sauce (or spicy mayo) to each bun and top with lettuce and a piece of the chicken fried steak. Top with remaining buns. Serve immediately.
