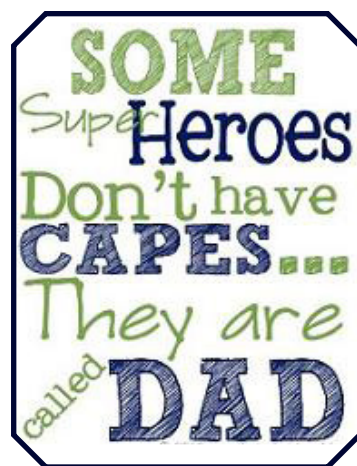

- Ingredients:**
- 8 oz. bacon, chopped
(Rath 12 oz. bacon on sale \$2.99!)
 - 1 onion, diced
 - 2 tbsp. all-purpose flour
 - 3 cups low-sodium chicken broth
 - 2 cups half-and-half
 - 1 russet potato, peeled and chopped into 1/2" cubes
 - 1/4 cups chopped green onions, plus more for garnish
(on sale 3/\$0.99!)
 - Kosher salt
 - Freshly ground black pepper
 - 1 lb. medium or large raw shrimp, peeled and deveined, roughly chopped.

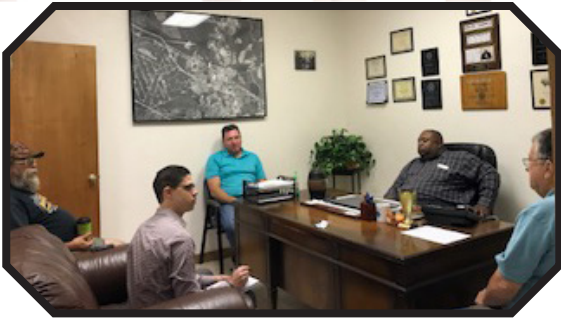
Directions:

- In a large pot over medium-high heat, brown bacon until crisp. Transfer bacon to a plate and reserve fat in pan.
- Add onions and cook until softened, 6 minutes. Add flour and stir continuously with wooden spoon until absorbed, about 1 minute.
- Stir in chicken stock, half-and-half, potatoes, green onions, salt and pepper and simmer on medium-low until potatoes are tender, 10 minutes.
- Add shrimp and simmer until pink, 2 to 3 minutes, then stir in half the cooked bacon. (Sea Best 30-40ct. raw shrimp 16 oz. on sale \$6.49!)
- Garnish with remaining bacon and green onions.
