## NO BAKE SUMMER BERRY ICE BOX CAKE

### Eat well

**Ingredients:**

- 19 oz. graham crackers
- 8 oz. cream cheese, softened (*Kraft Soft Philadelphia Cream Cheese 7-8oz on sale 2/\$5.00!*)
- 2 (3.4 oz.) packages vanilla instant pudding
- 2 1/2 cups cold milk
- 12 oz. Cool Whip
- 3 cups fresh strawberries, sliced (*on sale 2/\$4.00 each!*)
- 1 1/2 cups fresh blueberries (*on sale 2/\$5.00 each!*)
- 2 oz. white chocolate chips

**Directions:**

- Beat cream cheese and dry pudding mixes in large bowl with mixer until blended.
- Gradually beat in milk.
- Gently stir in Cool Whip, reserving 1/2 cup.
- Spread a thin layer of Cool Whip in a 9X13 pan just to coat the bottom.
- Layer 5 graham crackers across the center of the pan, then two more, breaking them as needed to fit around the top and bottom edges.
- Spread a layer of pudding mixture over grahams and top with a layer of blueberries and sliced strawberries.
- Place graham crackers on top of berries, then pudding mixture, then layer berries again.
- Repeat the graham-pudding-berries layer one more time (3 times total) and you should reach the top of the pan.
- Refrigerator for at least four hours or overnight until the graham crackers have softened completely.
- When ready to serve, melt white chocolate chips in a bowl as directed on package and drizzle over dessert.
- You can use a spoon to drizzle it over the tops of the berries or you can put it into a small zip-lock bag and snip off the corner for an easy "piping bag". *Recipe found at [www.cakescottage.com](http://www.cakescottage.com)*

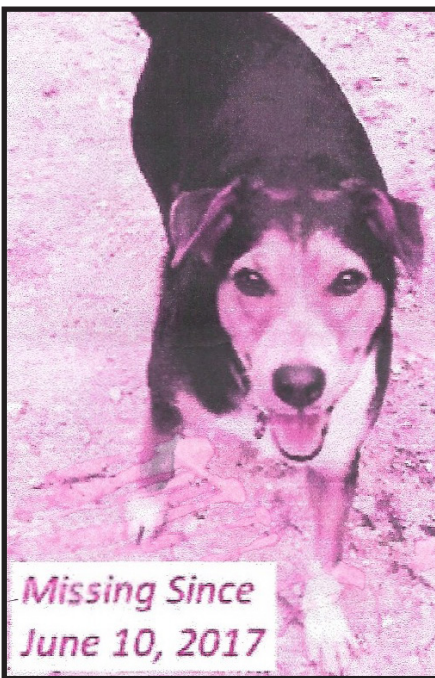


