As most of you know the Shepherd Volunteer Fire Department is 100% volunteer. We are in dire need of volunteers. We currently have a roster of 18 members. Eat well

Ingredients:

- 25 golden Oreos, crushed
- 6 tablespoons butter, melted
(Imperial margarine quarters 1lb on sale \$0.79!)
- 8 ounces cream cheese, room temperature
- 1/4 cup granulated sugar
(Imperial Sugar 4lb bag on sale \$1.69!)
- 8 ounces whipped topping, divided
- 1 box (3.4 oz.) banana cream pudding mix
- 1 cup milk (Hiland gallon milk on sale \$2.97!)

Directions:

- Mix the crushed Golden Oreos and butter. Press into the bottom of an 8"x8" or 9"x9" square pan. Chill 10 minutes.
- Beat cream cheese and sugar in a large bowl until smooth. Stir in 1 cup of the whipped topping until combined, then spread over crust in the pan.
- Add the pudding mix to a large bowl (you can use the same one you used before). Whisk in milk until pudding thickens. Once it has set, spread it over the cream cheese layer.
- Top with remaining whipped topping and some additional crushed Oreos for decoration.
- Optional: add 1-2 sliced bananas in between the cream cheese and pudding layer.

Free and Reduced-Price Meals Community Eligibility Provision (CEP)

The Shepherd Independent School District announced today a change to its policy for serving meals to children served under the National School Lunch Program and School Breakfast Program for the 2017-2018 school year for all Campus's. Schools qualifying to operate the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) provide breakfast and lunch to all children at no charge and eliminate the collection of meal applications for free, reduced-price, and paid student meals. This new approach reduces burdens for both families and school administrators and helps ensure that students receive nutritious meals.

The cost of A la Carte items and second meals are not covered under the CEP Program. You may put money on your students account for this.

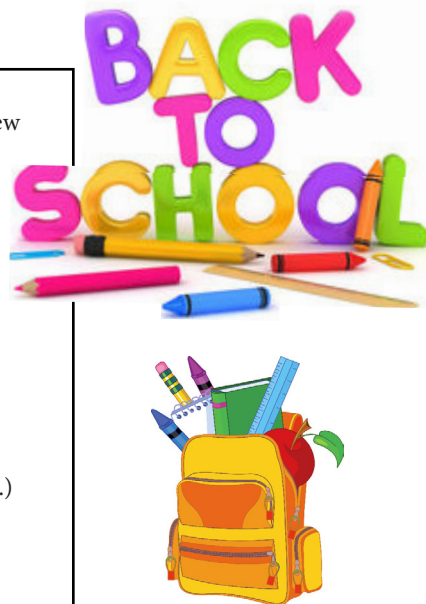

This restaurant is not to be confused with ‘Church’s Chicken’, instead it is a family business owned by Kebble Edison and her father, Clinton Edison. They have a place in Huntsville too. This new location at 108900 US Hwy 190, Point Blank, is a totally redecorated restaurant connected to an Exxon Station. Lawrence Pickett is the Pit Master. He is “The man behind it all” and he can cook! The BBQ is excellent. We were given samples of the Brisket, Ribs, Sausage and Chicken. All of it was delicious. It is well worth taking a drive out to ‘Church BBQ’ and enjoy their food. A one

meat plate is \$10.99; two meat plate is \$ 11.99 and three meats costs \$12.99. If you want to buy take-out, Beef is \$11.50 a pound, Whole Chicken is \$12.00, Sausage is \$10.00 and Beef is \$11.50. If you want 1/2 pound of anything, just half these costs. Sandwiches start at \$5.99- \$6.99. Desserts? Well, Buttermilk Pie is \$3.00 a slice, Pecan Pie is \$3.50 a slice. You can buy the whole pie if you want! This family business started 48 years ago. The new location is definitely a bonus to our county. Here is a reminder for all Propane users in Shepherd and surroundings. Even though the Feed Store on Loop 424 is now being converted to the “Community and Children’s Impact Center” you can still buy Propane at that location. The Family Restaurant, also on Loop 424 but closer to the south exit onto US 59, was vandalized last week.
